We are offically informing all Residents, Non-Residents, and Business Owners of this area with alarms. It is <u>YOUR RESPONSIBILITY</u> to have a responder(s) with a key or willing to take the responsibility to stay on scene until the owner arrives to reset the alarm. They must be listed with your Alarm Company, and lives within 30 minutes of the home and able to respond during the alarm at any time it goes off. If they have a key they must be able to open the home and provide the fire personnel the ablitiy to check out the home if needed and to be able to reset the alarm. If <u>YOU DO NOT</u> have anyone listed with the alarm company after the first false alarm incident you will be charged a flat fee of \$500.00 for each additional false alarm incidents after that.
