

**Caseville Township Board Meeting  
August 6, 2018**

Meeting called to order at 4:00 p.m. by Ben Willenberg.

Present: Ben Willenberg, Michelle Stirrett, Vicki Dufty, Laurie Marrocco and Jerry Platko.

Thirty eight citizens were present.

**Motion** by Stirrett second by Dufty to approve the agenda, the July 2, 2018 Board minutes, Treasurer's report and invoices in the amount of \$69,368.68. **Motion carried.**

**Motion** by Willenberg second by Stirrett authorizing the hiring of Ron Bieri for the demolition of the large building on the Caseville Road property at a cost not to exceed \$40,000. **Motion carried.**

**Motion** by Dufty second by Platko authorizing Jeff Bedford to power wash, paint and upgrade fascia and soffit on the two storage buildings at a cost not to exceed \$11,265. **Motion carried.**

**Planning Commission meeting – August 7, 2018**

**Motion** by Stirrett second by Marrocco approving the amended Master Deed for the Glen's as recommended by the Planning Commission. **Motion carried.**

**Mosquito/Insect Suppression**

The Board considered petitions received from residents regarding mosquito suppression and decided to change the intent to generalize the resolution to include gypsy moth and mosquitos since the gypsy moth millage has expired.

**Resolution 2018-04** by Stirrett second by Dufty to place a tax millage ballot proposal (as approved by Attorney William Fahey) for the purpose of insect treatments within the Township in the amount of .4000 (four tenths) of a mill for four years (2018 through 2021 inclusive). The ballot wording approved within the resolution. Roll Call: Aye: Stirrett, Dufty, Willenberg, Platko, Marrocco. Nay: None. Absent: None. **Resolution adopted.**

**Fee Schedule – Water final reads**

**Motion** by Dufty second by Marrocco to amend the fee schedule to include a final meter reading fee of \$50.00. **Motion carried.**

**Building Inspector – Soil Erosion/Wages**

**Resolution 2018-03** by Stirrett second by Platko repealing in its entirety Ordinance 2018-03 an ordinance to adopt by reference the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act due to the fact that the

Township does not meet the standards for issuance of such permits. Roll Call: Aye: Stirrett, Dufty, Platko, Marrocco, Willenberg. Nay: None. Absent: None. **Resolution adopted.**

At the June 11, 2018 Special Board meeting the Board voted a wage increase of \$3,500 for the Building Inspector to accommodate the increased work load due the issuance of soil erosion permits. **Motion** by Stirrett second by Marrocco to adjust the wage increase for the Building Inspector to \$1,200 for the extra three hours worked per week. **Motion carried.**


**Board Comments:**
