**Water Rates**

**Ordinance 2019-05** by Marrocco second by Platko amending Section 50 Water: Appendix A Water Rates to read: Ready to serve Charge = \$61.25. Water to be billed at \$5.00 per 1,000 gallons. Rates to be effective with the January, 2020 water bill. Roll Call: Aye: Marrocco, Platko, Stirrett, Dufty, Willenberg. Nay: None. **Ordinance adopted.**

**Building Inspector Report** given.

**Supervisor Update:** County approval was given for the Caseville Road driveway. Bid packages for the new building should be available shortly. Stated he is saddened by the shoreline erosion situation.

**Public Comments:**

Peggy Walz : Wants the Township to have curbside recycling. Costs are minimal. She is taking her recyclables to Bad Axe. Not recycling is hurtful for future generations and the cost is minimal. City people are used to recycling and it is a shame that the Township is so far behind.

Terry Ross: Stated he is a resident of Hume Township and was representing the Quiet Skies Coalition. He is concerned with the proposed low altitude jet tracking and training exercises. Information coming from the Commissioners is misleading. No demonstrations have taken place yet. He is available for information regarding the issue.

Jerry Wroblewski: Harbor is closed for the season. They are working with Wade Trim on the development of a five year plan. He noted that the recreation survey for the plan was available online.

**Board Comments:**

Platko: How is the Township involved in the recreation survey? He would like a copy of the results for Township reference.

Marrocco: Commended the harbor on working with Wade Trim on the plan. Survey questions were well formed and she is looking forward to the results. She was instrumental in forming the committee to address recycling and would be happy to share the results. Seasonal residents and low income citizens were among the reasons the Township does not have curbside recycling.
